Our CHSP, Brokerage and Home Care Packages provide:

- **Personal Care** – where we provide assistance with bathing, dressing, getting in and out of bed and mobility about the house.
- **Domestic Assistance/Home Help** – which offers assistance with cleaning, simple vacuuming, dish washing, laundry and hanging of clothes, ironing, shopping and preparation of meals.
- **Social Support and Activities** – may include short walks, chatting, reading, local outings (café, library, post office, shopping). Accessing local recreational activities etc.
- **Respite Care Services** – which provide families and carers with an opportunity to take a break from their caring role and have quality time on their own.
- **Social Support Groups** – or centre based respite provides socialization through a range of activities aimed at reducing social isolation. It allows clients to meet other people who may share the same language, interests and common history and culture.
